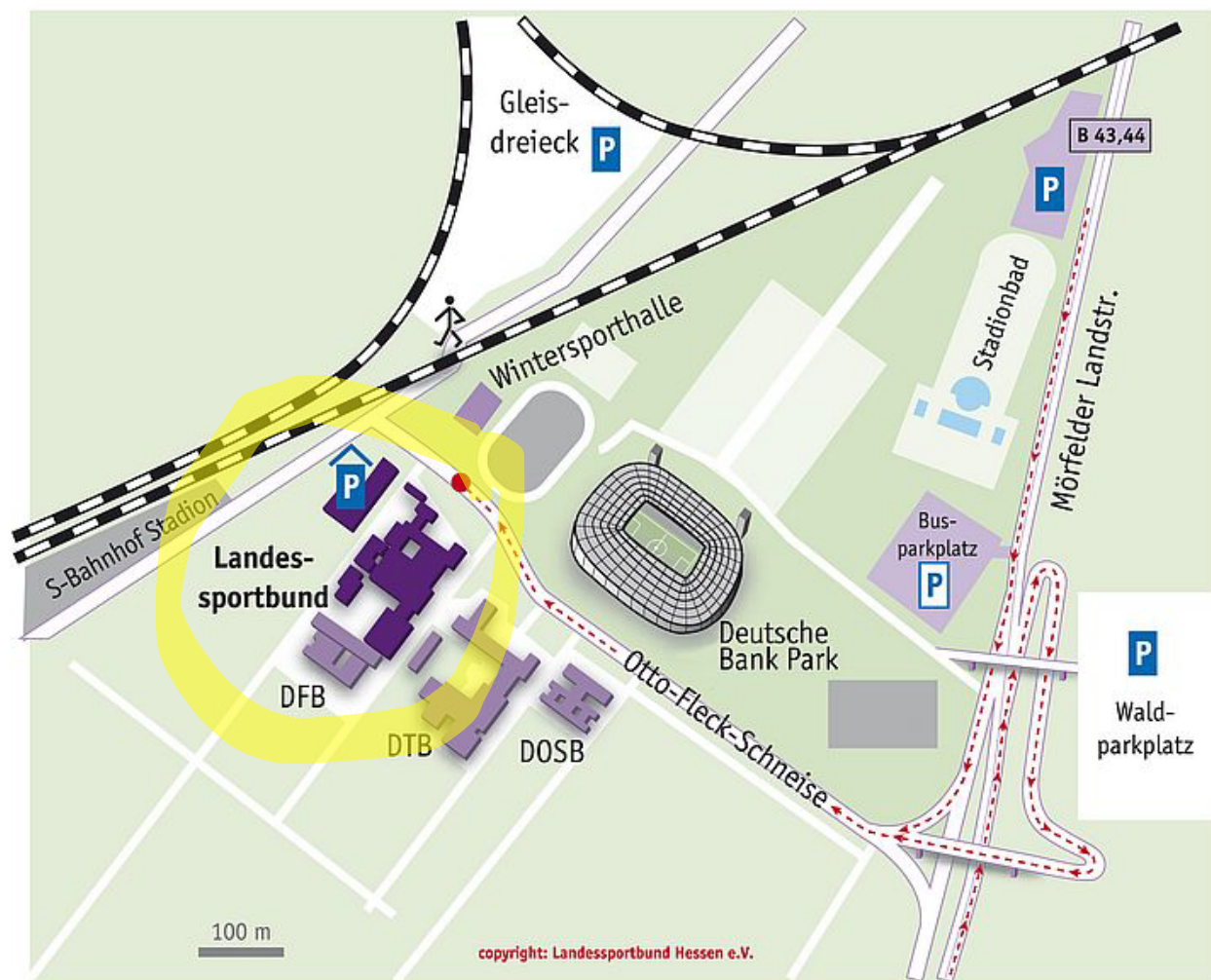

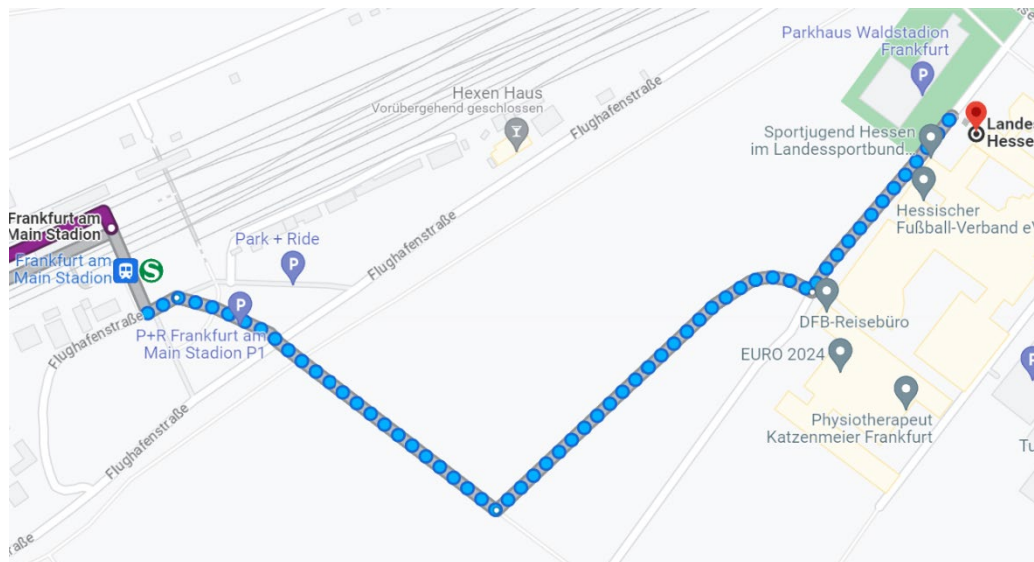

4 Directions to the venue

4.1 FRA airport

Take the S8 or S9 regional train (Regional train station in the airport, not Fernbahnhof (long distance) 6 min (3 stops) exit Stadion. Opposite direction as from main station. Walk about 10 min.



4.2 Frankfurt Main train station

Take the S8 or S9 6 min (3 stops) exit Stadion. Walk about 10 min.

5 Remote access

There will be setup a Webex, see the TSN web site, see [TSN TG Meetings | \(ieee802.org\)](https://www.ieee802.org/TSN-TG-Meetings/).

The meeting is primarily a f2f ad hoc meeting. There is no guarantee that the remote dial in with Webex is working and being stable. WiFi and a central small loudspeaker/mic (no professional Audio system) is available in the room.

6 Travel from Frankfurt to Berlin (Plenary)

There are trains from Frankfurt to Berlin at every hour. Some ICE (called Sprinter) travels in less than 4 hours with no stop in between. For example:

Frankfurt(Main)Hbf	starts	08:57
ICE 772	travel time	3h 58min
Berlin Hbf (tief)	arrives	12:55

Or

Frankfurt(Main)Hbf	13:02
ICE 578	3h 53min
Berlin Hbf	
Berlin Hbf (tief)	16:55

Or 15:02–18:57; Or ...

The ticket costs between €35 and €75 depending on the departure time (rate of today). Later, the cost may increase, especially 1 week or less before departure.
