RATIONALE FOR REVISION:

The definition of the ISS belongs in 802.1AC rather than 802.1Q.

802.1AC-2012 was based on text from 802.1Q-2011. Since then, amendments have made changes to the ISS and these have been incorporated into 802.1Q. This is probably wrong, and material should be moved from 802.1Q to 802.1AC. There may be a problem with 802.1Qbp as well.
