T1P1.1 PROGRAM MANAGEMENT WORKING GROUP**Mission**

The T1P1.1 Program Management Working Group provides standards planning and program management functions for projects assigned to T1P1 by Committee T1. When coupled with the functional responsibilities of other T1 entities, these functions will provide an efficient process for Committee T1 to facilitate consideration of complex projects.

Scope

The T1P1.1 Working Group will develop a standards program management process for Personal Communications to serve as a model for future standards focus areas.

The Program Management Working Group of T1P1 will perform:

Standards Planning functions which may include:

- Develop a standards program that:
 - o Designs a framework of standards development
 - o Identifies relevant fora
 - o Identifies objectives and milestones
 - o Facilitates common terminology with consistent definitions
- Determine T1 endorsement of programs
- Plan liaison activities with other organizations

Program Management functions which may include:

- Seek acceptance of responsibility by other fora for detailed standards development
- Harmonize schedules with other fora
- Monitor standards development programs in other fora
- Assess the impact on the overall program of schedule changes
- Facilitate liaisons between affected fora
