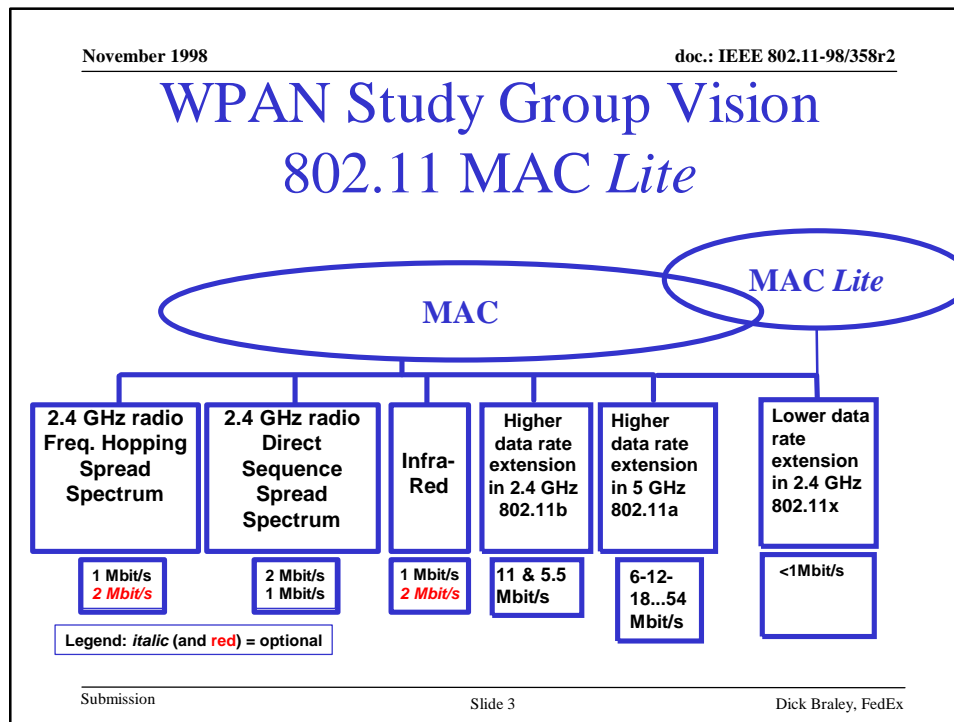
IEEE WPAN Study Group Status
