Nanjing tourist sites (highlights only):

- Dr. Sun Yet-sen's mausoleum (中山陵), and the surrounding forest area (钟山风景区)



- Other sites in the forest area where Dr. Sun Yet-sen's mausoleum is located:

- Xiaoling Mausoleum of Ming Dynasty (明孝陵)



- Ling-gu park (灵谷寺)



- Presidential Palace (总统府)



- Confucius Temple (a.k.a. Fu-zi-miao, 夫子庙), Qing-huai river (秦淮河) (Good to visit late afternoon and into evening to view the lights at night)



- Xing-jie-Kou, (新街口, Shopping center, i.e., the San Francisco Union Square of Nanjing)



- Ming City Wall (i.e., city wall built in Ming dynasty)



Restaurants/bars:

- My favorite Nanjinese food: Salty duck (南京盐水鸭), you have to try it!!



- Restaurant areas:
Xing-Jie-kou (新街口)
Fu-zi-miao (夫子庙) (particularly known for snack/dim-sum like food)
