IEEE 802.16 was pleased to receive the liaison statement of 18 March 2005 (IEEE L802.16-05/029) from 3GPP TSG-SA5 regarding use of the IRP methodology and IRP specifications. Please note that, in the meantime, IEEE 802.16 has approved a new project (IEEE P802.16i) that includes protocol-neutral MIB modeling. Related specification work, utilizing IRP methodology and IRP specifications, has started within this project under IEEE 802.16 Working Group's Network Management (NetMan) Task Group.
