## Call for Editorial Comments on P802.16Rev2/D0b

Deadline: 12 July 2007

The IEEE 802.16 Working Group's Maintenance Task Group <a href="http://wirelessMAN.org/maint">http://wirelessMAN.org/maint</a> is assigned to develop a draft revision (designed P802.16Rev2 within the Working Group) of IEEE Std 802.16. In preparation, the TG has circulated for comment an editorial consolidation of IEEE Std 802.16-2004, IEEE 802.16e, and IEEE 802.16f. Following resolution of comments intended to check the integrity of the consolidation, the project editorial team has prepared document P802.16Rev2/D0a.

At Session #49 in May 2007, the WG decided to create a new document P802.16Rev2/D0b by incorporating the material in the corrigendum draft P802.16-2004/Cor2/D4 into P802.16Rev2/D0a. Both P802.16Rev2/D0a and P802.16Rev2/D0b (neither of which is approved as a WG draft standard) are available:
