Document Format

In the main document, use heading styles so that the Outline Layout view provides a quick index into the document.

Fonts

Document Submission

Header

The document release date goes at the top left of each page. This template is set to automatically insert the current date in the header.

The document number goes in the upper right of the header. Determine the document number following the 802.16 Document Submission Instructions <<http://ieee802.org/16/submit.html>>.

Setting PDF Document Info Tags

In order for on-line indexing to function properly, several Document Info tags must be set in the final PDF. The preparer of the final document should, in Acrobat, set the "Title" tag to the title of the document, the "Subject" tag to the document number, and the "Author" tag to the author.
