

**Task Group Review of IEEE 802.16e-03/07r4
IEEE 802.16 Task Group e**

Deadline: 31 October 2003

Task Group e (on “Mobile Wireless MAN”) of the IEEE 802.16 Working Group on Broadband Wireless Access has developed a working document ([IEEE 802.16e-03/07r4](#)) constructed as an amendment to IEEE Draft P802.16-REVd/D1. The working document is based on submitted contributions, with refinement to follow.

The Task Group is seeking to refine this Working Document in preparation for submission to a Working Group Letter Ballot, planned for November 2003. This Task Group Review invites comments on IEEE 802.16e-03/07r4 for consideration at Session #28 (10-13 November 2003 in Albuquerque, New Mexico, USA).

Commenters are encouraged to be thorough and concise. Comments must identify specific concerns or areas to address and should propose specific text changes to the Working Document. Text for the Mobility Agent section is particularly solicited.

It should be noted that the Task Group Chair has specifically requested that contributors/commenters provide performance data, either actual or simulated, in support of proposed changes.
