# IPORPR WG Next Steps

---

- Charter shows completion of the framework document in August 2001. The document remains work-in-progress and will be left open and active. This will be refined as work progresses in IEEE 802.17.
- After November (802.17 cut-off for proposals) , IPORPR will go semi-dormant and wait until 802.17 comes close to producing substantial specs. Once that happens, IPORPR will re-charter itself to develop any needed protocol(s) for “IP over 802.17”.
- The IPORPR mailing list will remain past November. Should individual IEEE participation bring up issues for discussion in the IETF, those will go on the mailing list.
- Individual cross participation is encouraged between the IEEE and IETF now and after November.
- Note: The IPORPR WG has no opinion on contributions / proposals made with regards to MAC development within IEEE 802.17.
