# Comment Resolution Tracks

- Global Section
  - 4 comments dealt with; all resolved
- Intro Section (Clause 1)
  - 55 comments dealt with; all resolved
- Intro Section (Clauses 2, 3, 4)
  - 56 comments dealt with; 55 resolved
  - 4 punted to other clauses (1 to be dealt with by WG)
- MAC Section (Clauses & Annexes)
  - 193 comments dealt with by CRG; 191 resolved; 2 punted
  - Editorial license granted
- PHY section
  - 22 technical comments dealt with; all resolved; will request editorial license
  - 5 technical comments on Annex B pending (motion to be placed before WG)

# Comment Resolution Tracks

- Fairness Section
  - 36 comments dealt with; all resolved (2 withdrawn); none punted
  - License granted for 28 editorials
- Topology Section
  - 47 technical comments dealt with; 13 punted; rest resolved
  - 9 to PAH; 4 to other clauses
- OAM Section
  - 90 comments total, plus 1 punt; all resolved
  - No carry-overs or punts
- Bridging Section
  - All technical comments dealt with; 25 resolved, 8 carried over
  - Editorial license to be requested for remainder

# Process

- Each section will be dealt with in turn
  - Order corresponds to that in draft: Clause 0, Intro, MAC, PHY, Fairness, OAM, Bridging
- Editor will present summary of resolutions by ad-hoc
- Single motion to accept ad-hoc group's resolutions to resolved comments as a bucket
  - Any WG member can request that any comment be broken out of the bucket and debated by WG as a whole
  - Ad-hocs to resolve issues raised by comments authorized at this time (by acceptance of comments)
- Comments sent by ad-hoc to WG will then be debated and resolved
  - Chair may limit debate in the interests of progress
- Authorize creation of D1.1 based on instructions

# Draft Creation/Posting Schedule

(Subject to revision based on workload)

**The next inter-meeting period is extremely short (36 days)**

- 18 days for Editors to create D1.1 from accepted comments
  - Draft clauses sent to Chief Editor by October 23
- 2 days for Chief Editor to clean up, review and assemble D1.1
  - Draft 1.1 ready by October 25, posted on October 26
- Comment period runs from October 26 to November 5
  - 11 days to review draft and post comments
- Comment database posted for review and proposed resolutions by November 6
  - 6 days to review comments prior to meeting
  - No time for proposed resolutions
- Kauai Plenary meeting starts November 11th

# Clause 0 Comments

- Submitted to Clause 0: 4 comments
  - 1 x Technical Binding
  - 1 x Technical
  - 2 x Editorial
- All comments resolved (accepted/accept-modified)
  - Strange data rates in frontmatter (2.396 Gb/s, anyone?)
    - Remove these strange rates
  - State diagrams, as usual
    - Chair requested to form the SAH (State Diagram Ad-Hoc – no, I'm not kidding)
  - Misc editorial stuff (C programming ops, TOC)
    - Fixed



# Clause 2, 3, 4 Comments

- 56 comments: all resolved (5 punted to other CRGs and duly resolved)
  - 53 accepted/accepted-modified; 3 rejected
  - Editorial stuff
    - C-style operators, sorting of acronyms, capitalization, etc
  - Terminology & definitions (lots and lots)
  - Fix names of standards bodies for referenced stds.
  - Bit ordering and byte sequence conventions
  - State machine conventions and description
  - Too many RFCs referenced in Annex E (#61) – put before WG
  - Avoid use of word “register” – implies implementation
