Introduction

The current 802.20 Policies and Procedures were developed in January 2004. Since that time a significant number of revisions have been made to the overall 802 Policies and Procedures. The overall 802 Policies and Procedures has precedent over the working group P&P. Therefore, any conflicts are resolved by using the overall 802 Policies and Procedures. Some Working Groups basically reference the overall 802 Policies and Procedures except for specific additional rules such as for officers' elections. An example is the 802.16 and 802.17 Policies and Procedures.

Proposed Revision of the Current 802.20 Policies & Procedures

The proposal is the 802.20 Working Group adopt a similar approach as 802.16 and 802.17.

Therefore the proposed is to revise the 802.20 Working Group P&P as follows.

Delete/eliminate all text except the following statement:

The IEEE 802.20 Working Group will operate under the P&P governing IEEE 802 except as stated in Appendix A for the Officer Elections procedures.
