Overview

- As of D1.1 there were several issues with how the source files (i.e., the MIB and YANG modules and associated files) were produced, edited and managed
- This presentation is in support of comments against D1.1 that propose a new process to simplify development of the modules and incorporation into the drafts
- Key elements of this proposal include:
 - Only the source files are edited
 - All source files are run through standard syntax checker and formatting tools.
 - Source files are directly imported into the Framemaker Book,

Basics

- This proposal builds on what is done in the IETF, 802.1 Yangsters and similar groups.
- Commentors "should" submit YANG/MIB source along with comments unless they are "simple" editorial comments.
- Source submissions that do not pass the syntax checkers and/or have not been through the formatting tools may be rejected.
- Only the source files are edited and are incorporated automatically into the draft.
- Microsoft Word (or similar) can be used to generate a "change barred" document showing the changes in the source files.
