TR Clause 3.5.7 page 03.4 line 39
This statement is not true. 3.2.7 says that the length of the pad field is (0,minFrameSize -(8*n+2*addressSize+48). The PAD field of a Tagged MAC Frame is different in that it is allowed to be 4 bytes shorter. Remedy: change "identical" to "identical except in the following respect". Add a sentence: "For Tagged MAC frames the value of n in the PAD field calculation may be either the length of the MAC Client Data or the combined length of MAC Client Data and QTag Prefix."
