Objective 6

PoEPlus shall support a minimum of 30 Watts of power at the PD PI.

However, based on ISO numbers of 720mA We have 29.7W at the PD

### What do we want to do?

- Not do anything
  - 29.7W to one significant digits is 30W
  - The vote in July 2005 was taken on 5W increments
  - The spec allows a surge past 720mA
- Change the objective
  - What value should we use?
  - PD or PSE interface?
- Change the architecture to meet 30W at the PD interface
  - Move to a 4 pair only solution
- Remove the objective
  - Objective 5 is enough (Max power within practical limits)
