## MMF ad hoc meeting minutes, 23<sup>rd</sup> October 2014

  - 'SRS generator update' Piers Dawe
- Discussion topics:
  - Piers gave an update of his work on stressed eye simulations using three variants of the test setup, including using a Gaussian jitter option found on many test equipment pattern generators. He was aiming for 4.3 dB SEC and the J2 J4 target values in Draft 3.2, and got very close to these targets with one method. He chose 4.3 dB because a simulation of the worst transmitter and link gave SEC of 3.9 dB, and a simulation of the TDEC of the worst transmitter gave 4.4 dB.
  - There was some discussion on whether MPN was being double counted with the current definitions of SEC and the SRS test OMA.
  - An invitation was made to share measurements of real Tx TDEC values with the ad hoc.
