Chair presented the second slide (See Slide #31) of the IEEE SA Copyright Policy slides. Chair noted – “By participating in this activity, you agree to comply with the IEEE Code of Ethics, all applicable laws, and all IEEE policies and procedures including, but not limited to, the IEEE SA Copyright Policy.”

Chair asked if there were any questions regarding the summary he had provided on the reflector regarding his update to the 802.3WG. There were none, but the chair reminded everyone that he would speak with the 802.3 WG Chair, David Law, prior to the May 2022 Interim, regarding the progress of the Task Force.
