Study Group 15, Question 2 (Q.2/15) has recently prepared several preliminary drafts for the G.983.x series (Broadband Passive Optical Networks. One of these concerns the application of WDM overlays on PON systems, and is intended to be submitted for consent at the next SG15 plenary in May. This document is currently in the form of a Working Document, as listed below:
