 - Evaluate link security architecture issues (i.e. layer model, threat analysis, etc)
 with the objective to identify the broader scope that can be common to all MAC
 solutions
 - 2. Develop a PAR and 5 Criteria for a new standard for link security that can be applied to IEEE 802 networks, and in particular to 802.3 networks
 - Make a recommendation on the placement of the project within IEEE 802 and/or existing working groups
