- Moved 2 Objectives into PAR A
 - Move the HSSG add the 40km reach objective to PAR A: Support at least 40km on SMF. (A: 49/1/11, 802.3: 22/1/7)
 - Move that the HSSG include the copper objective, "to support at least 10m over a copper cable assembly," into PAR A. (A: 47/0/22, 802.3: 20/0/11)

 - Define a family of physical layers for 40 Gb/s operation
 - Support at least 100m on OM3 MMF
 - Support at least 10m over a copper cable assembly
 - Support at least 1m over a backplane
 - All: 41 / 17 / 10, 802.3: 28 / 8 / 4
 - Move the HSSG request 802.3 working group approval of the PAR A objectives contained in agenda_01_0507 slide 21. All: 34 / 20 / 5, 802.3: 18 / 11 / 6
- Passed (Procedural) Motion:
 - The Higher Speed Study Group recommends the IEEE 802.3 WG form a 40G Study Group to evaluate definition of approximately 40Gb/s MAC data rate and related PHY capability to IEEE Std 802.3. All: 33 / 22 / 7, 802.3: 16 / 15 / 5
