Maintenance

Mr. Diab suggested that Piers Dawe Chair an Ad Hoc to discuss the issue of jitter and how changes to clauses referencing jitter impact the IEEE 802.3 (802.3bh) revision. An alternate approach to addressing the issue of jitter is to submit a Maintenance comment.

Schedule

Mr. Diab reviewed the schedule for 2nd Sponsor Group recirculation ballot. The schedule summarized approximate ballot open and close, post results, post comments, post comments with proposed responses, and meet to consider comments dates. The schedule supports a second recirculation ballot (May - July) with a target Standards Association Standards Board (SASB) document submission date of August, 2012. It was noted that July 20, 2012 is the submittal deadline for the RevCom package supporting this schedule. The recirculation package will only contain the changed pages. It is anticipated that a request for approval will be made at the July IEEE 802/802.3 meeting, which will support the August SASB meeting submittal deadline of July 20th. Refer to:
