PROPOSED REVISION TEXT:

"1.4.120 Fibre Distributed Data Interface (FDDI): A 100 Mb/s, Fiber optic-based, token-ring local area network standard (ISO/IEC 9314 series of standards)."

25.5.4.2, PD 2 & PD 3, the reference in the Feature column should be to TP-PMD, ANSI X3.263: 1995. (The FCD Ballot on 9314-10 closes 5/14/2000. Depending on timing and if successfully closed, this would probably be the better reference.)

RATIONALE FOR REVISION:

1.4.120, FDDI is specified in a series of standards not a single standard. The specified standard is LCF-PMD, which is only referenced for its specification of the duplex SC connector.

The reference for 100BASE-TX should be TP-PMD, not LCF-PMD.
