RATIONALE FOR REVISION:

A network of 10BASE-T at the edge and fiber in the backbone can have 5 repeaters, see clause 13.4, "Transmission System Model 2". This has been a part of the standard since October of 1993. It is unfortunate however that there isn't a figure in that clause of the standard that illustrates the example that everyone would want to see. This was due to the current revision of Clause 13 being developed as part of the 10BASE-F project and hence the topologies illustrated are concentrated on fibre. This change would finally remedy this situation.
