PROPOSED REVISION TEXT:

Change the wording to read: "A non-rigorous way to describe this test setup would be using a transmitter with a known T_{on} ."

RATIONALE FOR REVISION:

The current text uses '(' and ')' around the portion of the sentence for no reason, causing the sentence to be effectively broken / incomplete reading as >>A non-rigorous way to describe this test setup would be (using a transmitter with a known T_{on}).<<. The same text is present in Clause 75 and Clause 60 alike.

This issue existed back in 802.3-2012 and has not been remedied to date. It has been presented in IEEE Std 802.3av and IEEE Std 802.3ah back in 2004. I do not have access to intermediate .3ah versions to verify when it was first introduced in the draft.
