17 PROPOSED REVISION TEXT:

19 Add a new Subclause 1.1.6 'Word usage' that reads as follows. Note that
20 <I> and </I> indicates italicised text and that <FN> indicates a
21 footnote:
22
23 The word <I>shall</I> indicates mandatory requirements strictly to be
24 followed in order to conform to the standard and from which no deviation
25 is permitted (<I>shall</I> equals <I>is required to</I>).<FN1><FN2>
26
27 The word <I>should</I> indicates that among several possibilities one
28 is recommended as particularly suitable, without mentioning or
29 excluding others; or that a certain course of action is preferred but
30 not necessarily required (<I>should</I> equals <I>is recommended that
31 </I>).
32
33 The word <I>may</I> is used to indicate a course of action permissible
34 within the limits of the standard (<I>may</I> equals <I>is permitted
35 to</I>).
36
37 The word <I>can</I> is used for statements of possibility and
38 capability, whether material, physical, or causal (<I>can equals is
39 able to</I>).
40
41 <FN1>The use of the word <I>must</I> is deprecated and cannot
42 be used when stating mandatory requirements, <I>must</I> is used only
43 to describe unavoidable situations.
44 <FN2>The use of <I>will</I> is deprecated and cannot be used
45 when stating mandatory requirements, <I>will</I> is only used in
46 statements of fact.

49 RATIONALE FOR REVISION:
50
51 All documents shall include Clause 1. Overview. Clause 1 at a minimum
52 shall include the 1.1 Scope and 1.2 Word usage. If draft has
53 1.1 Scope, 1.2 Purpose then 1.3 shall be included and entitled Word
54 usage. The Word usage subclause has to contain the text provided
55 above.
56
57 As IEEE Std 802.3-2018 has 1.1 Overview then 1.1.1 Scope, following

1 these requirements in respect to subclause numbering would result
2 in significant renumber of cross-references throughout the standard.
3 As a result we have been granted a dispensation to use subclause
4 1.1.6 for the Word usage subclause.

7 IMPACT ON EXISTING NETWORKS:

9 None, this new subclause relates to Word usage that we have always
10 followed based on subclause 6.4.7 'Shall, should, may, and can' of
11 the IEEE-SA standards board operations manual. The new subclause is
12 a verbatim copy of that text with the addition of the two footnotes.
