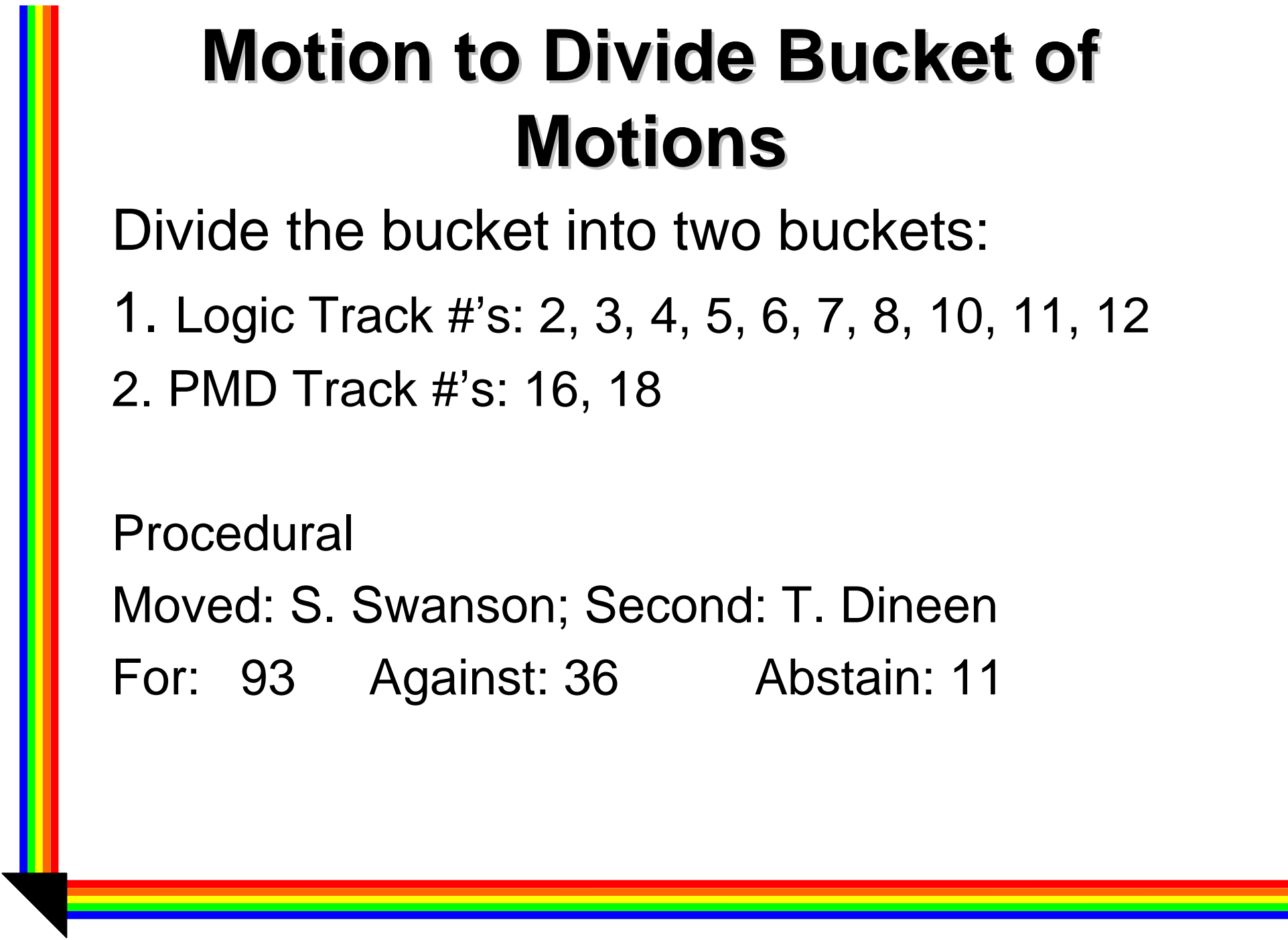

This motion was withdrawn. It was considered too technically detailed for the Working Group.

- 100 meters over installed MMF
