# IEEE 1802.3-2001 Reaffirmation

---

- Standards require reaffirmation/revision every 5 years
- Voted in July 2006 to proceed with reaffirmation
- Initial sponsor ballot
  - Ballot opened 10<sup>th</sup> August 2006
  - Ballot closed 9<sup>th</sup> September 2006
- Comments received stated standard out of date
  - Comment resolution agreed that standard should be withdrawn
    - But advice from staff is was need to complete balloting
- Voted in November 2006 to continue

Motion : IEEE 802.3 recommends that IEEE Std 1802.3-2001 should be withdrawn and that this recommendation should be provided to the balloters. The recirculation cover letter and comment database should reflect this recommendation.
- Sponsor recirculation ballot
  - Ballot opened 1<sup>st</sup> March 2007
  - Ballot closed 16<sup>th</sup> March 2007

## Options

- [1] Motion from IEEE 802.3 to EC requesting withdrawal
- [2] Direct chair to submit project to RevCom
  - [a] Then do nothing – next revision in 5 years
  - [b] Then do [1]
- [3] Do nothing – administrative withdrawal in Dec 2007

- Request the IEEE 802.3 chair progress 1802.3 to approval.
- Request that IEEE 802 EC request withdrawal of IEEE Std 1802.3 immediately after Standards Board approval.
