T11 has meet twice since the last Plenary of 802.3:

- **Mar. 29 - Apr. 1, 2010 in Pasadena, CA.**
- **Jun. 7 - 10, 2010 in Minneapolis, MN.**

FC-PI

- **FC-PI-5 (16 GFC) second T11 letter ballot.**
- **FC-MSQS was approved for a T11 letter ballot. MSQS will contain the test procedures required for FC-PI-5.**
- **FC-PI-6 (32 GFC) project proposal was approved by T11.**

FC-PI-6

- **New presentations for FC-PI-6.**
- **Two presentations showed that 28 Gb/s is feasible.**
- **A first attempt was made at a link budget.**
 - **Single lane SFP connector.**
 - **The module will be retimed and most likely require equalization.**
- **Responded to OIF with recommendations.**
 - **Fibre Channel uses a single lane which is different from other cases.**

- **First meeting of Energy Efficient Fibre Channel**
 - Adam Healey gave an overview of Energy Efficient Ethernet.
- **An INCITS Award for Technical Excellence was granted to David Cunningham and Adam Healey.**
