

## Required/Unsatisfied Comment Summary as of 7/18/19

- Draft 3.0: 40\* unsatisfied comments from 5\* commenters +8 unclosed comments from 1 commenter
  - Mostly (36 comments) from 4 commenters on PLCA issue from WG ballot 34 from 2 commenters who commented in WG ballot on related issues
- Draft 3.1: 8 unsatisfied comments on draft 3.1 from 1 commenter +3 unclosed comments from 1 commenter
  - 8 unsatisfied from existing disapprove voter from d3p0 & WG ballot
  - Expect 10 disapprove w/comment to drop to 6 or 7 (+1 disapprove w/o comment) on d3p1
