- September 2012 interim is hosted at the ITU-T facilities
- Proposal for a joint workshop between ITU-T and IEEE 802.3
 - Target date is *Saturday* September 22nd
 - At the ITU-T facilities
 - Will have 3 sessions
 - Access, Core Networking, Review/Brainstorming
 - Detailed logistics covered by 802.3 Exec Sec

Status To-Date

- Email introduction with ITU-T leadership
- Introduction of topic to IEEE-SA staff
- Initial call with ITU-T leadership
 - Agreed on 2 topic areas
 - Topics limited to areas of mutual interest
 - Topic with more contributions to be done during morning session. Other to be done in the afternoon session with brainstorming / review
 - Next call to be scheduled after plenary
 - In part to allow for new SGs to participate if approved

- Identify topics of interest within 802.3 to propose to ITU-T leadership

 - Please provide a title and *brief* abstract
 - Please indicate if you would like to or would be willing to co-present on the topic
 - Co-presenter can be a fellow 802.3 or ITU-T participant
 - Request that you also include the TF/SG Chair
 - This will make it easier to group proposals if needed
 - Deadline for proposals is April 16th
 - List of selected proposals will be aggregated, reviewed by WGAC and shared with WG by email
- Propose call with ITU-T leadership to review proposals from each group
 - Target a call prior to next 802.3 interim
- Report back to 802.3 Working Group in July and email if needed
