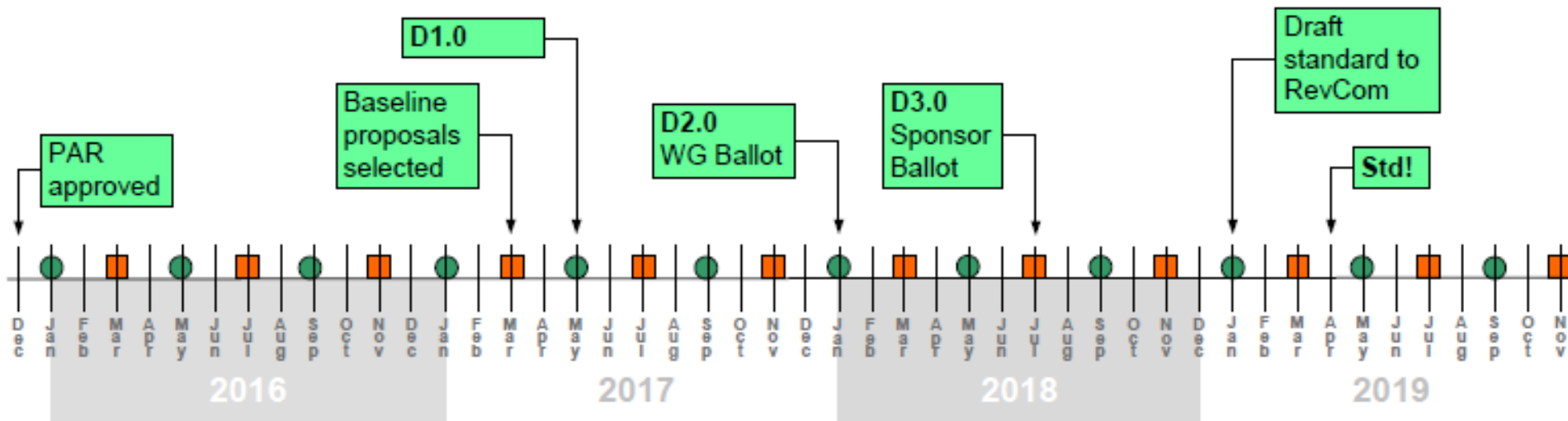
Accept modified GATE message format per slide #8 in kramer\_3ca\_1\_031
