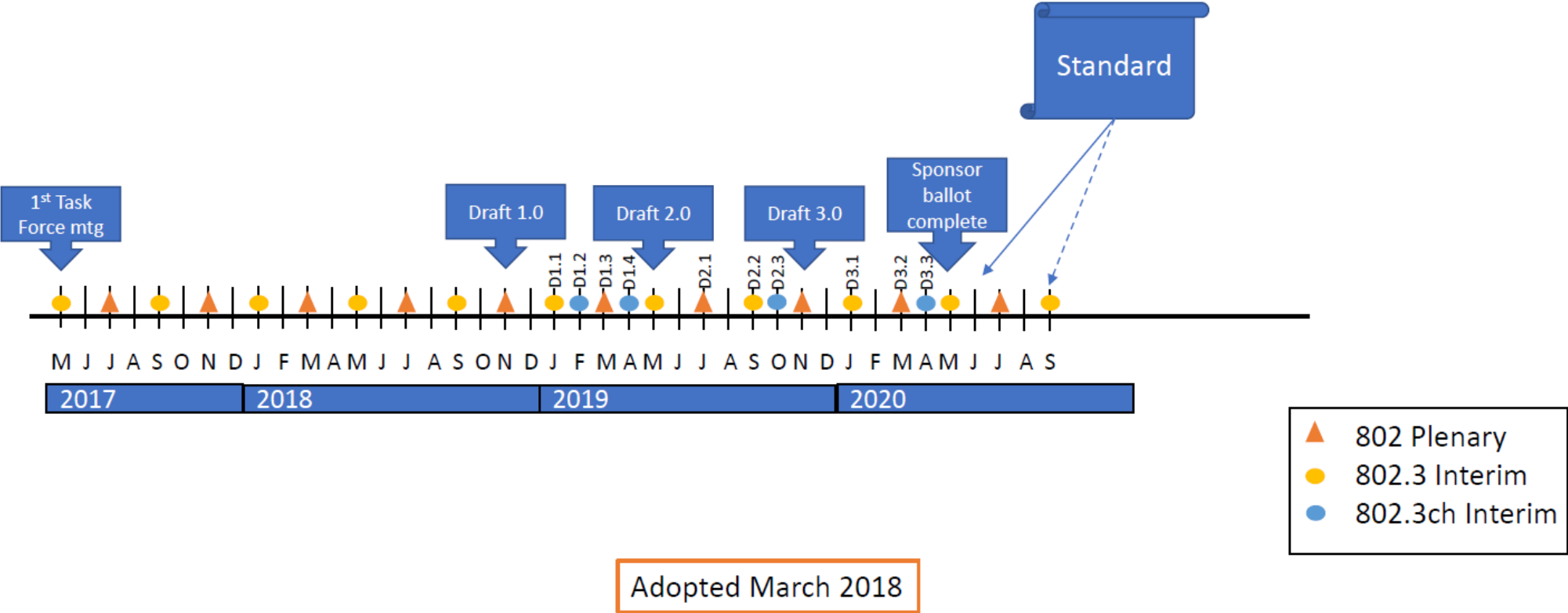

Meeting week plan

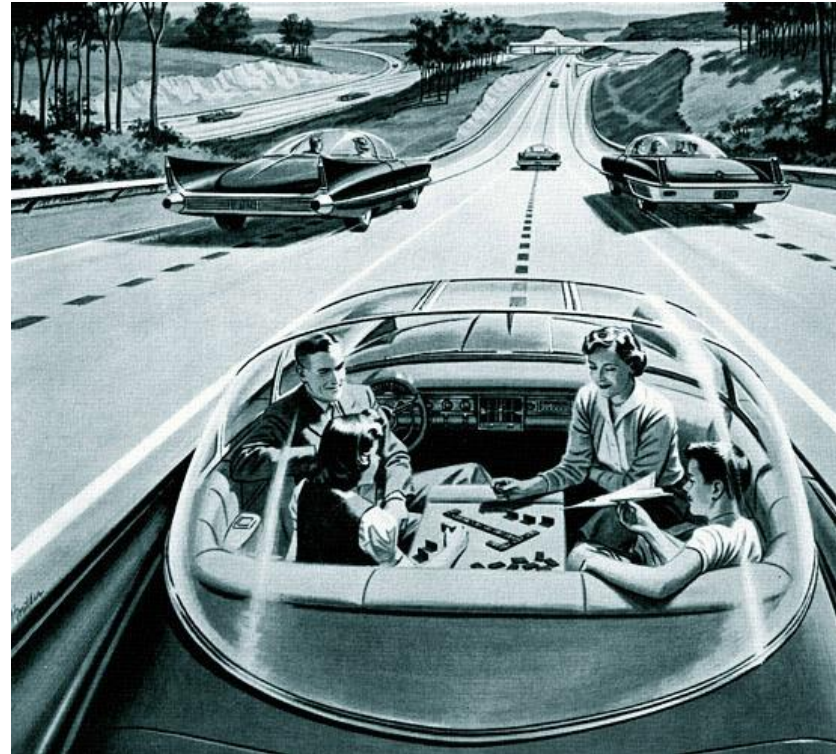
Goals for the meeting
