Meetings:

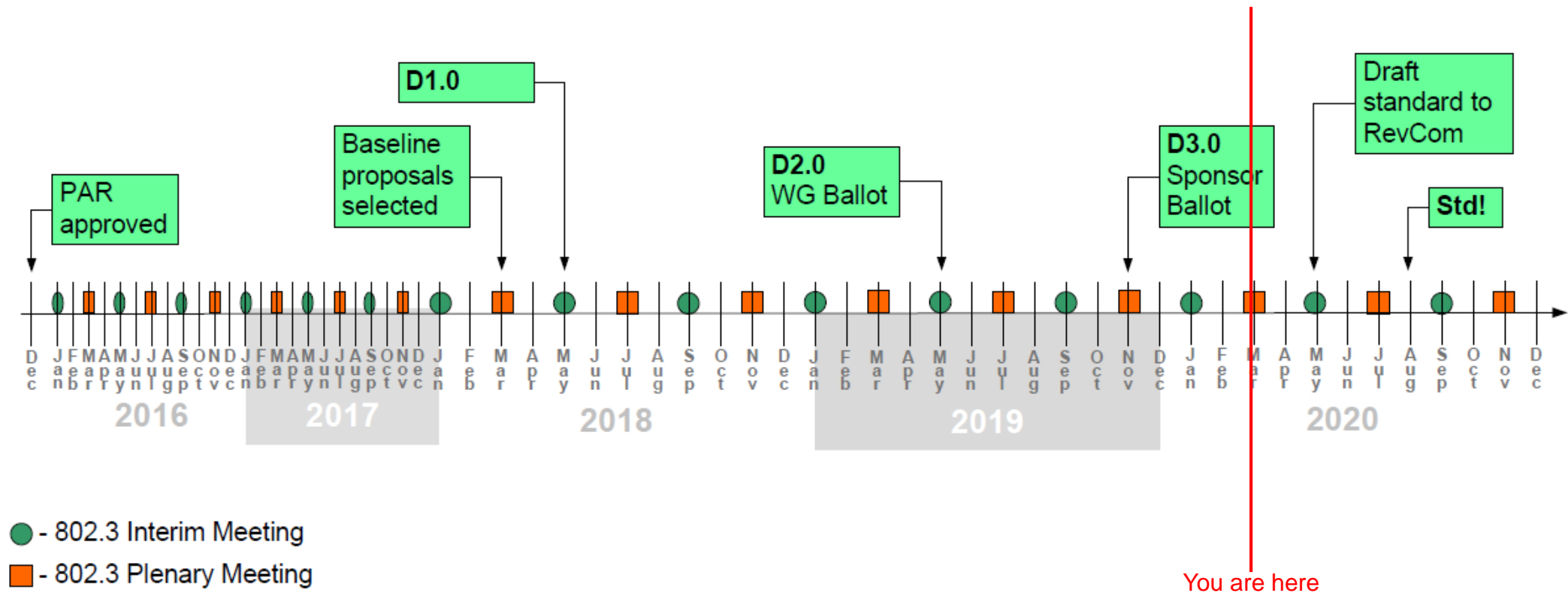
- Met during the January 2020 interim meeting series in Geneva, CH
