Started TF comment cycles on draft which includes both ACT and TDD requirements



Ad hoc and additional Interim meetings held to help drive consensus and start comment resolution

Draft activities since November 2025 Plenary

- 1st TF review (D0.a)
 - D0.a TFR started on December 3, 2025
 - D0.a TFR was to close on January 4, 2026 AOE
 - D0.a TFR extended until 3 pm EST January 8, 2026
 - 414 comments received
- 2nd TF review (D0.b)
 - D0.a TFR started on February 2, 2026
 - D0.b TFR closed on February 13, 2026 AOE
 - 329 comments received
