# March 2009

Costs for Rome & Vancouver are up >20% just since our August-September poll

Cost for Rome is 2.5x cost for Vancouver

Rome costs \$425/night + \$1000 Reg fee

Vancouver: \$175/night + \$400 Reg fee

Expect US-\$ costs will continue to rise

Poll: 54% for Rome, 32% for Vancouver
