 - Added a definition for a cg_timer (code group timer) to align with 100BASE-X
 - Rewording of Signal Detect specification
 - Rewording of SX and LX receiver test procedures
 - Combed through PICs for clauses 38 and 39
- Converted all Negative ballots to Affirmative w/ Comments
- Concluded that a 2nd LMSC recirculation should be conducted
