  - LMSC sponsor ballot to start after this meeting

#### 802.5w Corrigenda

- 802.5's first electronic sponsor ballot completed with no disapprove votes
- Sponsor recirculation ballot to start after this meeting
- Conditional approval granted for forwarding to RevCom

- 802.5x Source Routing over VLANs
  - Call for interest and an editor
  - If insufficient interest, PAR to be withdrawn in March 2000
- 802.5z Link Aggregation
  - First draft adopted by working group
  - 802.5 ballot to start after this meeting
