Get IEEE 802 **Ô** Program Agreement June 4, 2002 revision 2

The terms of the program to achieve maximal, unencumbered availability of IEEE 802® standards as agreed follow:

1. Current standards only

It is agreed that only current standards will be included. Superceded, withdrawn, historical standards and drafts will not be available in the program but will be available for purchase.

2. PDF only

It is agreed that only PDF format will be made available at no charge after a six month wait period. Print and PDF will be available for purchase during the wait period, and print documents sales will continue after the six month wait period.

3. Six month wait period

The six-month wait period is intended to generate some initial revenue from the sale of new and revised standards before they are placed in the program. The wait period begins in the month of the PDF publication. Superceded documents will be available in the program until the new document is available for purchase.

4. Three year pilot

The program is a three year pilot program beginning in May 2001. It is our intent to establish a long-term program. During the pilot period, program terms (e.g., sales/sponsorships, the six-month wait period, content, prices, etc.). will be evaluated and refined as necessary in a good faith attempt to establish a viable permanent Get IEEE 802TM program.

5. Annual review

At least annually in March of each year, and more frequently, if needed, the program terms will be reviewed and, if warranted and mutually agreed to, adjusted based on a \pm --20% deviation in budgeted revenues per the *Get IEEE 802* \hat{O} Financials document dated June 4, 2002 to ensure the continued viability of the program. The adjustment(s) will be based on the needs of IEEE-SA, IEEE 802 and the marketplace. If mutual agreement cannot be achieved, the pilot program will be terminated..

6. Sponsorship

a. The IEEE 802 LMSC will support the program at the level of \$75 per paid plenary meeting attendee, recognizing the revenue impact of allowing IEEE 802® standards to be made available in PDF format at no charge.
