IEEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bh) Ethernet Maintenance #10 (Revision) Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard

The following is the Clause 13 'Procedure for Conditional Approval to Forward a Draft Standard' report for IEEE P802.3 (IEEE 802.3bh) Ethernet Maintenance #10 (Revision) which received conditional approval to proceed to RevCom submittal at the July 2012 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval.

The schedule presented to July 2012 closing IEEE 802 EC meeting when requesting conditional approval was:

- Recirculation ballot open date July 18th 2012
- Recirculation ballot close date August 6th 2012
- Proposed interim meeting date (if required) September 23rd 2012

The recirculation occurred essentially in accordance with the plan presented.

b) After resolution of the recirculation ballot is completed, the approval percentage is at least 75% and there are no new valid DISAPPROVE votes.

The ballot results after resolution are:

The approval rate after resolution of the ballot is greater than 75% and there were no new negative DISAPPROVES votes.

c) No technical changes, as determined by the WG Chair, were made as a result of the recirculation ballot.

An editorial required (ER) comment, not associated with a vote, was received from Editorial Coordination that reads 'This draft meets all editorial requirements'.

e) If the WG Chair determines that there is a new invalid DISAPPROVE comment or vote, the WG Chair shall promptly provide details to the Sponsor.

Two editorial required (ER) comments, two technical required (TR) and one General Required (GR) comments were received from an existing disapprove voter.

The Working Group chair determines the two ER comments as out of scope as they are against unchanged text, and the two TR comments and the one GR comments as being a restatement of an already rejected, rebutted and recirculated comment.
