Procedure for conditional approval to forward a draft standard report

The following is the Clause 12 'Procedure for conditional approval to forward a draft standard' report for IEEE P802.3bq 25/40GBASE-T which received conditional approval to proceed to Sponsor ballot at the November 2015 IEEE 802 Plenary meeting.

a) Recirculation ballot is completed. Generally, the recirculation ballot and resolution should occur in accordance with the schedule presented at the time of conditional approval

The recirculation balloting is complete. The fourth recirculation ballot occurred essentially in accordance of the plan presented.
